





ABOUT: Parker & Jules was launched by two friends, Nancy Parker and Jules O'Carroll, in 2018. They design every pattern and colourway with an English aesthetic retuning heritage with a contemporary lens. Their prints flow together so clients can confidently design multi-print spaces. They continually move the collection forward reflecting customers' desire for innovative new colour and print alongside their creative incentive to evolve and design.

Parker & Jules's goal is to be a community business with sustainable English production sold in global design markets. Therefore, they only print to order and carry no stock, minimising their environmental footprint. They have an artisan quality level in digital production of fabric and wallpaper, using the finest natural materials (linen, recycled velvet, grasscloth, coated parchment wallpaper), working with long-term partners and customers.

With their commitment to sharing their belief that print is uplifting, interesting and sophisticated, they produce two collections a year, offering wide choices of colours and materials of fabrics and wallpapers.

Each design in the collection is original and designed to both stand alone and play with other prints in the collection. They have main prints - the stars of scheme, which are complex often multi-colour prints and generally larger scale, they can also be used in small amounts to visually punctuate a scheme.

Their small, often bi-colour, prints are designed to slot into schemes as balancing acts - those useful little prints which hold everything together again and again, but can also act as a background print over large scale areas, adding quiet interest.

"We believe every print should have a story and a strong place in the collection linked to English style icons: Cotswold countryside, icons of print in English interiors from crewel work, paisley and chintz to the Bloomsbury set and the Arts & Crafts movement, reinterpreting them in our signature style."

Dovetailors became known for their collaborative approach, working in partnership with their customers, taking their ideas – however unusual – and using Dovetailors' design expertise and furniture making skills to bring them to fruition.

ABOUT: Goldfinger, an award-winning B Corp and social enterprise, champions the belief that high-end design can and should be both planet and people positive. They specialise in crafting bespoke, made-to-order furniture from Treecycled© timber and other sustainable materials for both homes and businesses, thereby diverting waste from landfill and reducing carbon emissions. Sustainability is and always has been the core of their mission; they aim to educate future generations of consumers, designers, and makers on conscious design without compromise. For Goldfinger, sustainability isn't a business strategy, it's their fundamental purpose.

Their team collaborates closely with renowned interior designers and architects across the country to translate their values and stories into tangible designs. Through their extensive network of craftspeople and in-depth knowledge of sustainable English timbers, they assist each client in designing and crafting unique bespoke furniture for a variety of spaces, including private residences, restaurants, cafés, hotels, wellness spaces, offices, and co-working spaces.

Goldfinger primarily sources timber from British trees felled due to disease, weather, or development - a process we call 'Treecycling.' By working directly with local sawmills, Goldfinger saves thousands of kilos of timber each year from incineration, transforming it into timeless furniture. This approach gives felled trees a second life, sequesters carbon stored within the timber, and establishes a new circular supply chain.

With Treecycled© wood, Goldfinger ensures a high degree of supply chain traceability. As part of their maker's mark, they offer to stamp the exact GPS coordinates of the original tree's location onto Treecycled© products, embedding transparency into each design and connecting customers to its natural heritage.

In addition to their environmental initiatives, Goldfinger also pursues a social impact mission. The Goldfinger Academy aims to enhance our community's career opportunities and well-being by teaching woodworking, design, and employability skills. The Academy runs week-long traineeships through our Future Makers Programme, a free outreach programme that provides training, career guidance, and mentoring for 16-29-year-old learners from low-income backgrounds.





ABOUT: Based in rural East Sussex, Custom Fronts is a small family company, female-led with a team of makers, designers, and artists. The a-ha moment came to them when they discovered a perfectly preserved 1950s plywood kitchen in a mid-century bungalow in Brighton.

It was a reminder of that kitchens were once built to last and to look good. Unable to find anything like that on the market, they decided to make them. Kitchens for those who loved the planet but didn't want to compromise on aesthetics. A beautiful kitchen you wouldn't throw away. And as sustainable design is irrelevant if hardly anyone can access it - they made it to fit IKEA, a simple and accessible cabinet system.

Founded by Emer Gillespie, a former fine arts photographer and lecturer, the company was started out of personal desire for original lighting options and a simple yet ambitious vision: to combine exceptional local craftsmanship and ethical practices into a sustainable family-run business.

From the beginning, Spark & Bell established a distinct aesthetic of contemporary designs that reference Art Deco and Mid-Century elegance, and which emphasise the intrinsic beauty in materials like brass, reeded glass, wood and ceramics. The range has expanded to include a wide selection of decorative interior wall lights, pendants, chandeliers, ceiling lights, table lamps and recently, IP44 rated bathroom lights.

With the handmade to order nature of its lighting, Spark & Bell also collaborates with trade and retail customers on one-off pieces, developing bespoke lights for residential and commercial interiors.

Championing circular design principles in daily practice, Spark & Bell supports domestic suppliers within a 200-mile radius and collaborates with local artisans working in wood, ceramics, cork and jesmonite.

It has also taken to developing materials from sources headed for landfill – its Jewel series uses recycled plastics made in-house from salvaged CD cases. This appreciation for local heritage craft and dedication to sustainability is resonating with a growing customer base that values both environmental responsibility and unique aesthetics.

Spark & Bell has received B Corp™ certification with a score of 100.6. Highly impressive for a company undergoing its first assessment under the internationally recognised standard of social and environmental responsibility.

We firmly believe that local manufacturing is an important pathway to a more sustainable future. By producing our goods locally, we can greatly minimise carbon emissions associated with transportation and significantly reduce waste packaging. We are committed to using only recyclable materials for our packaging and strive to minimise plastic usage in our products as much as possible."

The core designs are easily adaptable, and they are more than happy to discuss customised alternatives, be it in colour, size or geometry. Samples are available to make decisions easier. Collaborative initiatives are also welcomed.

BACKGROUND: The founder of Hounddog Design is Nick Newlands. Nick's background is in mechanical design engineering. In 2018 he attended a designer-maker course at the Rowden Atelier school of fine furniture in North Devon. It was a year that set the wheels in motion and where a passion for aesthetic design took hold. A recent shift in focus from furniture to lighting has made Hounddog Design more manageable, allowing for more interesting and adaptable concepts to emerge.



PRODUCT RANGE: The Stroma lights use slender unsupported blades assembled around a circular former, with materials options that provide a world of possibilities:

1. Fine-line birch ply core, with eco-laminate facings

These are normally configured coloured and white on opposing faces, which produces a pleasing animated effect. They produce a warm natural light.

2. Solid compact colour-core laminate

In soft white, these produce a cooler, more architectural feel.

3. Forescolor core with eco-laminate facings

A recent addition - the facings are white; the core is coloured. Forescolor is a wood fibre product with organic dyes and melamine resins. A funky style alternative.

We also produce lamp bases using a laminated form of fine-line birch ply and colour-core laminate. This allows a unique contemporary aesthetic which can be adapted to meet customer preferences.


